C Is the area given to these units sufficient, given the recommended spacing of 6m?

D Further to that is there sufficient space for the units given the spacing, as it is difficult from the plan to establish what is usable space?

E The spur of land beside Hill View Farm, is camping permitted in this area?.

F The storage area for boats and caravans appears to include the area of the proposed wash block. Is this the intention?
